

Turning your hearing aid ON and OFF




ON (door closed) (door open)



Use **Blue** batteries


Cleaning

Cleaning your ear mould






Wipe over the hearing aid with a wet wipe every day



If the tubing looks blocked, wash the ear mould in water

You **MUST** remove the hearing aid before doing this

DO NOT wash the hearing aid



When dry, push the ear mould tube back onto the hearing aid

Cleaning your slim tube






Wipe over the hearing with a wet wipe every day




If the tubing looks blocked, clean it with a cleaning wire

Pull the tube away from the hearing aid



Insert the wire into the top of the tube

Push the cleaning wire all the way through



Pull the cleaning wire out of the dome end of the tubing



DO NOT remove the dome from the tube It is not safe to do so If this happens the tube and dome **must** be replaced

Care

Replacing the tubing/slim tube

The tubing on your hearing aid needs to be changed every **6 months**. Contact Audiology a few weeks beforehand to arrange an appointment.

If you or someone you know would like to know how to replace the tubing/ slim tube on your hearing aid, leaflets are available which will show you how to do this.

Repairs

If your hearing aid becomes lost, broken or stops working, contact Audiology for an appointment.
