Ask for Easy Read information about Breast Screening



Breast screening is for women aged 50 and older.



Breast screening checks are to see if your breasts (boobs) are healthy



When you are invited for a breast screening check you can ask for an **accessible or easy read letter** to explain what will happen.



At the breast screening unit, you will have images taken of your breasts. These are called **mammograms**.



After your breast check (mammogram) you are sent your results. You can ask for your results letters to be in easy read.
